

C.R.M. (M) 928 of 2025

In Re : An application for bail under Section 483 of BNSS, 2023 filed in connection with Deganga Police Station Case No.203 of 2014 dated 08.04.2014 under Sections 302/201 of the Indian Penal Code and Sections 25/27 of Arms Act.

Heard learned counsels for the parties.

In turning down the bail prayer of the petitioner on 10th May, 2024, this Court has observed that the petitioner was on bail and after examination of 18 witnesses, he absconded, for which trial could not be proceeded with. The petitioner was arrested on 11th December, 2023 and is in custody since then.

Learned counsel for the State opposes the prayer.

This Court is informed that examination of the investigating officer is in progress.

Considering the conduct of the petitioner and also since trial is at its fag end, this Court is not inclined to release the petitioner on bail lest he absconds again resulting in further delay in trial.

Accordingly, prayer for bail is rejected at this stage.

The application for bail is thus disposed of.
