Considering the incriminating materials available in the case diary including the statement of the minor victim and the statement of independent witnesses as also the fact that the petitioner has been absconding since 2years and 4months, I do not consider this to be a fit case for granting anticipatory bail to the petitioner.

The application for anticipatory bail being **C.R.M. (A) 2331 of 2025** is, thus, rejected.
