This application under Article 227 of the Constitution of India is at the instance of the defendant No.1 praying for a direction upon the learned Additional District Judge, Ranaghat, District-Nadia to dispose of Miscellaneous Appeal No.29 of 2024 expeditiously.

In view of the order sought and proposed to be passed there is no necessity to direct issuance of any notice upon the opposite party. However, the learned advocate for the petitioner shall be obliged to forward a copy of this application along with this order upon the opposite party or the learned advocate representing the opposite party before the learned trial judge.
