

C.R.M. (M) 969 of 2025

In Re : An application for bail under Section 483 of BNSS, 2023 filed in connection with S.T.F. Police Station Case No.11 of 2023 dated 27.02.2023 under Sections 120B/489B/489C of the Indian Penal Code.

Heard learned counsels for the parties.

The petitioner is in custody for more than 2 years and prays for bail.

Opposing the prayer, learned counsel for the State submits that the petitioner has 22 criminal antecedents to his credit. Out of 5 witnesses 3 witnesses have been examined so far.

Considering the nature and gravity of the offence, antecedents of the petitioner and prima facie involvement of the petitioner therein, prayer for bail is rejected at this stage.

The application for bail is thus disposed of.
