3. The instant writ petition stands disposed of by directing the Secretary of the West Bengal Central School Service Commission to take necessary steps to consider the application for transfer on special ground made by the petitioner in accordance with law at the earliest but positively within a period of eight weeks from the date of communication of this order.
