Heard the learned counsels for the parties.

Perused the case diary.

It appears that the petitioner has already deposited 50 per cent of the finally assessed amount before the Electricity Authorities.

Copy of document evincing the same is taken on record.

In view of the above and considering the materials available in the case diary, I am inclined to grant the application for anticipatory bail to the petitioner.

In the event of arrest, the petitioner shall be released on bail upon furnishing a bond of Rs.10,000/- with two sureties of like amount each, one of whom must be local, to the satisfaction of the Arresting Officer and also be subject to the conditions as laid down under

Section 438(2) of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 corresponding to Section 482(2) of the BNSS, 2023 and on further condition that the petitioner shall not threaten or intimidate witnesses.

The application for anticipatory bail is, thus, allowed.
