This is an application for restoration of the writ petition by recalling of an order dated July 4, 2025.

It appears that the instant writ petition was dismissed for default on July 4, 2025 by this Court.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that due to other engagement in the different court, he could not appear before this Court on the day of hearing. So, he prayed for recalling of the said order. It appears that the instant writ petition dismissed for default on July 4, 2025, the instant application for restoration was filed within ten days from the date of dismissal.
