Learned counsel for the State has

 appears that warrant of arrest has been
 issued against the Director of defaulting
 company and the case is fixed for
 execution report on 25.07.2025.

As such as this Court finds that the Officer is proceeding in accordance with law.

Accordingly, the writ application is disposed of with the direction that the Certificate Officer shall make all endeavour to dispose of the certificate proceedings expeditiously, preferably within 60 days from the date of communication of this order.
