Learned advocate for the petitioner submits that the petitioner is in custody for more than a year and there has been no progress in the case inspite of the charge-sheet having been submitted.

Learned advocate for the State submits that 758 gm of brown sugar were recovered from the exclusive possession of the petitioner and prosecution is exerting all efforts to complete the trial.

Having regard to the quantity seized, I am of the view the Section 37 of the NDPS Act is attracted.

Hence, the prayer for bail of the petitioner is **Rejected.**

State is directed to expedite the progress of the trial and take the same to its logical conclusion.

Accordingly, CRM (NDPS) 888 of 2025 is **dismissed**.
