C.R.M. (A) 2489 of 2025

In Re:- An application for anticipatory bail under Section 438 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 corresponding to Section 482 of the Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita, 2023 in connection with Bolpur Women PS Case No.06/2025 dated 15.03.2025 under Sections 85/109 of the Bharatiya Nyaya Sanhita, 2023.

Heard the learned counsels for the parties.

Perused the case diary.

It appears that the petitioner and the alleged victim had been married since 2001. It is also alleged that on one occasion, after an altercation, the petitioner threw a kettle at the victim, which caused certain injuries.

Considering the above and other materials available in the case diary and the fact that charge sheet has been submitted, I am inclined to grant anticipatory bail to the petitioner.

Accordingly, in the event of arrest, the petitioner shall be released on bail upon furnishing a bond of Rs.10,000/- with two sureties of like amount each, one of whom must be local, to the satisfaction of Arresting Officer and subject to the conditions as laid down under Section 438 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, corresponding to Section 482 of the Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita and on further condition that the petitioner shall not threaten

or intimidate witnesses or tamper with evidence in any manner whatsoever.

The application for anticipatory bail being **C.R.M. (A) 2489 of 2025** is, thus, allowed.
