An application for anticipatory bail under Section 482 of the Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita, 2023 in connection with Lalgola P.S. Case No.1097 of 2024 dated 07.11.2024 under Sections 21(C)/29 of the NDPS Act, 1985.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that other than a statement of a co-accused there is no material present against the present petitioner.

Learned counsel for the State submits that charge-sheet was submitted long ago and a proclamation has been issued against the petitioner. Anticipatory bail of the similarly circumstanced co-accused was denied by this Court.

Considering the materials available in the case diary, the fact that a proclamation has been issued against the petitioner and the restrictions contained in Section 37 of the NDPS Act, I do not consider this to be a fit case for granting anticipatory bail.

The application for anticipatory bail is, thus, rejected.
