1. Appellant/complainant is represented by the learned Advocate.
2. Respondents are present before this Court.
3. In pursuance of the direction passed by this Court dated 20.05.2025 a report is submitted by this Superintendent of Police, Sundarban Police District, South 24 Parganas which indicates that the direction passed by this court has been communicated to the parties.
4. It is said by the learned Advocate for the appellant that the matter in dispute has already been settled outside of the Court and the appellant does not intend to proceed further with this appeal.
