This is an application wherein petitioner has prayed for early disposal of his Narazi petition dated 17th October, 2022 pending for disposal before learned Chief Judicial Magistrate, Purba Medinipur, Tamluk.

It is submitted on behalf of the petitioner that being aggrieved by the final report in the form of FRT filed by investigating agency, the petitioner filed Narazi application before the trial court on 17th October, 2022 but the said application has not yet been disposed of in spite of passing nearly two and a half years.

Having heard learned counsel appearing on behalf of the petitioner and Mr. Sur, learned counsel appearing on behalf of the State, I find that the prayer made therein is innocuous and is required to be allowed for the ends of justice.

In such view of the matter, CRR 2489 of 2023 is disposed of with a direction upon the Court below to dispose of the petitioner's application dated 17th October, 2022 at the earliest preferably within a period of thirty days.
