This application under Article 227 of the Constitution of India is at the instance of the plaintiff praying for a direction upon the learned Civil Judge (Sr. Div.), 1st Court, Barasat to dispose of the Title Suit No.129 of 2010 expeditiously.

The learned advocate appearing for the petitioner submits that July 28, 2025 has been fixed for further cross-examination of D.W.1.

In view of the order sought and proposed to be passed there is no necessity to direct issuance of any notice upon the opposite parties.
