The petitioner being aggrieved by
the inaction of the police authorities has
approached this Court to take appropriate
steps.

Learned advocate for the State
has submitted a report which reflects that
in connection with Gopalnagar P.S. Case
No. 558 of 2021, the police authorities

have submitted charge-sheet on or about 20th December, 2024 under the relevant provisions of law before the learned ACJM, Bongaon.

Having considered that the police authorities have already submitted charge-sheet, I grant liberty to the petitioner, who has set the law into motion, to take appropriate steps under Section 173(8) of the Cr.P.C., if he is aggrieved by any act and/or action of the police authorities in spite of submitting the charge-sheet.

It is further directed that if any application is preferred, the learned Magistrate would dispose of the same within a period of 45 days from the date of filing of such application.

With the aforesaid observations, WPA 17048 of 2024 is disposed of.
