Petitioners are aggrieved by the inaction of the
police authorities, as such approached this Court.

State has submitted a report. Report reflects that
Haripal Police Station case no. 422/24 dated 16.07.2024
was registered for investigation on the basis of the

addressed, as such further pendency of the writ petition
