An application for anticipatory bail under Section 482 of the Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita, 2023 in connection with Islampur Police Station Case No.1110 of 2024 dated 13.11.2024 under Sections 420/406/34 of the IPC.

Report filed by the State is taken on record.

Video recording kept in a pen drive is also taken on record.

Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that the dispute is civil in nature. The petitioners have paid a part of the alleged dues without prejudice.

Learned counsel for the State opposes the prayer for anticipatory bail and relies on the subsequent statement of the de facto complainant in which he has been admitted receiving a part of the alleged dues.

Considering the nature of allegations and the materials available in the case diary and the fact that during pendency

of the proceeding a part of the alleged dues has been paid by the petitioners without prejudice, I am inclined to grant anticipatory bail to the petitioners.

In the event of arrest, the petitioners shall be released on bail upon furnishing a bond of Rs.10,000/- (rupees ten thousand) each with two sureties of like amount each, one of whom must be local, to the satisfaction of the Arresting Officer and also be subject to the conditions as laid down under Section 438(2) of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 corresponding to Section 482(2) of the BNSS, 2023 and on the further conditions that the petitioners shall cooperate with the investigation, shall meet the investigating officer once a fortnight till submission of report in final form and shall not threaten or intimidate witnesses.

The application for anticipatory bail is, thus, allowed.

Personal appearance of the investigating officer is noted and dispensed with.
