Heard the learned counsels for the parties.

Perused the case diary.

Considering the nature of allegations, the fact that at the material point of time the petitioner and the husband were not staying together at the same place and the fact that the petitioner has her infant to take care of, I am inclined to grant anticipatory bail to the petitioner.

In the event of arrest, the petitioner shall be released on bail upon furnishing a bond of Rs.10,000/- with two sureties of like amount each, one of whom must be local, to the satisfaction of the Arresting Officer and also be subject to the conditions as laid down under Section 438(2) of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 corresponding to Section 482(2) of the BNSS, 2023 and on further condition that the

petitioner shall co-operate with investigation and shall not threaten or intimidate witnesses.

The application for anticipatory bail is, thus, allowed.
