An application for anticipatory bail under Section 482 of the Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita, 2023 in connection with Jalangi P.S. Case No.18 of 2025 dated 16.01.2025 under Sections 21(c)/25/29 of the NDPS Act, 1985.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the only material available against the petitioner is the statement of a co-accused which is inadmissible in evidence.

Learned counsel for the State files a report which is taken on record and opposes the prayer for anticipatory bail and submits that apart from the statement of the co-accused there is a criminal antecedent of the petitioner. A charge-sheet has been submitted.

Considering the materials available in the case diary and the fact that the petitioner has a criminal antecedent and in view of the restrictions contained in Section 37 of the NDPS Act, I do not consider this to be a fit case for granting anticipatory bail.

The application for anticipatory bail is, thus, rejected.
