1. None appears on behalf of the writ petitioners. Mr. Dhiraj Trivedi, learned Deputy Solicitor General of India appearing on behalf of the Union of India is however, present. Ms. Banerjee, learned advocate appearing for the respondent no. 8 is also present.
2. Though none appears on behalf of the writ petitioners in connection with the instant interlocutory application, however, it reveals to us that by filing the instant interlocutory application, the writ petitioners have prayed for recalling of the order dated 18.12.2025, as passed in the writ petition,

whereby and whereunder the instant writ petition was dismissed for want of prosecution.
