There is a delay in filing the instant writ petition. Sufficient grounds have been shown and this Court is satisfied with the reasons given for not preferring the writ petition within the period of limitation. Sufficient grounds have been made out for the absence of the writ petitioner on 02.04.2025. Hence, the order is recalled and the writ petition is restored to its original file and number. Accordingly, **CAN 1 of 2025** is **allowed** and **disposed of**.

Considering the nature of reliefs prayed for in the writ application, learned counsel representing the State shall file a report in the form of an affidavit on the next date of hearing.
