Heard learned counsels for the parties.

The petitioner is in custody for more than a year and prays for bail.

Learned counsels for the State and the de facto complainant oppose the prayer.

Bail prayer of the petitioner was turned down earlier by this Court considering the material on record on 23rd December, 2024. Thereafter the witnesses have been examined. The witnesses have implicated the petitioner in the alleged offence. Sufficient incriminating material has transpired against the petitioner during investigation also. There is no change in the material on record that warrants a favourable order for the petitioner at this stage.

Considering the nature of the offence and prima facie involvement of the petitioner therein, prayer for bail is rejected at this stage.

Learned trial Court is directed to expedite the trial without granting any unnecessary adjournment to either of the parties.

The application for bail is thus disposed of.
