1. IA No.: CAN 1 of 2025 is an application seeking leave to file an appeal.
2. Learned Advocate appearing for the writ petitioner, on instructions from the writ petitioner who is present in Court, submits that the writ petitioner does not wish to proceed with the writ petition any further.
3. Bank is represented.
4. Since the appellants claim themselves guarantor of the borrower whose property was sold, we add the appellants as party-respondents in the appeal. We grant leave to the appellants to prefer the appeal.

5. As the writ petitioner does not wish to proceed with the writ petition itself, impugned order passed in the writ petition is set aside.
