The petitioner is aggrieved by the fact that no steps having been taken in connection with the progress of Netaji Nagar PS Case NO. 71 of 2025 dated 19.03.2025. The petitioner complains of acid burn injuries being inflicted upon the petitioner, being a lady.

The State has submitted a report. The report reflects that the steps have been taken and the accused persons are on *interim* bail. Steps have also been taken by the Investigating Officer.
