The petitioner is in custody for more than five years and renews his prayer for bail.

Learned counsel for the State opposes the prayer.

Bail prayer of the petitioner was turned down on two earlier occasions considering the material on record. There is no change in circumstances which warrants a favourable order for the petitioner at this stage. This Court is informed that three more witnesses will be examined by the prosecution.

In view thereof, prayer for bail is rejected at this stage.

Learned trial Court is directed to expedite the trial without granting any unnecessary adjournment to either of the parties.

The application for bail is disposed of.
