Secretary, W.B.B.P.E. shall take an appropriate
decision thereon, within a period of fourteen weeks
from the date of communication of a copy of this order.

With the above observations and directions this writ petition being WPA 17245 of 2025 stands disposed of.

However, there shall be no order as to costs.
