C.R.M. (NDPS) 979 of 2025

In Re : An Application for bail under Section 483 of the Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita, 2023 filed in connection with Baishnabnagar Police Station Case No. 610 of 2025 dated 25.05.2025 under Sections 21(c)/27A/29 of the Narcotic Drugs and Psychotropic Substances Act, 1985.

Learned advocate appearing for the petitioners submits that the petitioners are in custody for six months and from four persons, 346 bottles of Phensedyl have been recovered; although charge-sheet has been submitted, but there has been no progress in the case.

Learned advocate appearing for the State, on the other hand, opposes the prayer for bail and submits that the reasons for delay are beyond the control of the prosecution as one of the accused persons is absconding.

I find that both the petitioners are women. Having considered their period of detention and the quantum of seizure, I am inclined to release the petitioners on bail. As such, the prayer for bail of the petitioners is **allowed**.

Accordingly, the petitioners viz., 1. **Puja** and 2. **Santi** shall be released on bail upon furnishing bond of

Rs.20,000/- each, with two sureties of Rs.10,000/- each, one of whom must be local, to the satisfaction of the learned Special Court under the NDPS Act, Additional District Judge, 4th Court, Malda.

If on bail, the petitioners shall be physically present on each and every date so fixed by the learned Special Court and shall not leave the jurisdiction of the district of Malda without the leave of the learned Special Court.

The application for bail, being CRM (NDPS) 979 of 2025, is, thus, disposed of.
