Learned advocate for the petitioner submits that the petitioner is in custody for more than seven years and six months and there is hardly any progress in the trial of the case, the possibility of the trial being concluded in the near future is bleak, as such, the petitioner, on any stringent conditions, may be released on bail.

Learned advocate for the State submits that the cross-examination of the investigating officer of the case is in progress, as such, the prosecution's evidence is at the fag end.

Considering the stage of the case, I am not inclined to enlarge the accused on bail.

Hence, the prayer for bail of the petitioner is
Rejected.

However, the trial court is directed that no unnecessary adjournment be granted to any of the parties and the trial of the case would continue inspite of any resolution of the local Bar.

Accordingly, CRM(M) 1302 of 2025 is **dismissed**.
