Mr. Sen, learned Additional Government
Pleader submits a photostat copy of the charge-sheet
submitted in connection with Tala Police Station Case
No.06 of 2024 dated 13.01.2024. The said charge-
sheet has been submitted on or about 29th June,
2024.

Petitioner approached this Court expressing
the anxiety that there was no progress in the
investigation of the case. However, since the charge-
sheet has been submitted before the jurisdictional
court and the petitioner is aggrieved of the nature of
the investigation conducted by the police authorities,
petitioner would be at liberty to file necessary

application under Section 173(8) of the Code of Criminal Procedure before the learned ACJM, Sealdah or any court wherein the present case has been transferred by the learned ACJM, Sealdah.

With the aforesaid observations, WPA 18689 of 2024 is disposed of.

There will be no order as to costs.
