The petitioners are aggrieved by the inaction of the police authorities. The records of the case reflect that an information was sent to the Superintendent of Police, Purba Bardhaman on or about 05.07.2022, but, no steps has been taken till date.

The dispute is relating to a land. The petitioners are unable to furnish fresh circumstances presently available.

Since none appears on behalf of the State, Ms. Rupsha Chakraborty, learned advocate, who ordinarily appears on behalf of the State, is directed to

appear on behalf of the State. Her appearance may be regularized by the concerned authorities.

In case, there are inconveniences, the petitioners would be at liberty to file afresh before the Officer-in-charge/Inspector-in-charge of Memari Police Station and the concerned police authorities will act in accordance with law.

With the aforesaid observations, WPA 18408 of 2022 is disposed of.
