1. Affidavit of service filed by the petitioner is taken on record.
2. The petitioner's complaint against illegal encroachment over the Government plot of land is pending consideration before the State authority.
3. Learned advocate representing the private respondent denies the allegation.

5. In view of the above, the instant writ petition is disposed of by directing the Assistant Engineer, PWD (Roads) Directorate, Contai Sub-Division,

Government of West Bengal, respondent no. 4 to consider and dispose of the representation made by the petitioner, strictly in accordance with law, after giving reasonable opportunity of hearing to all the necessary parties, including the petitioner, at the earliest, but positively within a period of twelve weeks from the date communication of this order. The said respondent shall pass a reasoned order and communicate the same to all the necessary parties, including the petitioner, immediately thereafter.

6. The writ petition stands disposed of.
7. Urgent certified photocopy of this order, if applied for, be supplied to the parties expeditiously on compliance of usual legal formalities.
