Learned counsel appearing on behalf of the petitioner submits that the petitioner was a victim of calls spoofing. It is alleged that OTP was given by the victim and Rs. 2 lakhs was siphoned off from his account.

Learned counsel appearing on behalf of the State opposes the prayer for anticipatory bail and submits that the amount went to the account of the present petitioner.

Considering the serious nature of allegations and the incriminating materials available in the case diary, I do not consider this is to be a fit case for granting anticipatory bail.

Accordingly, the application for anticipatory bail of the petitioner is rejected.
