Heard learned counsels for the parties.

It appears that in the present case the petitioner was
granted bail. After addition of a more serious charge, bail
was cancelled and warrant of arrest was issued.

for anticipatory bail.

Therefore, the application for anticipatory bail is
dismissed as not maintainable.
