Learned advocate appearing for the petitioner submits
that although 6363 bottles of Pheysedyl were recovered but the
petitioner is innocent and has been implicated on the basis of
statement of co-accused.

Learned advocate for the NCB on the other hand
produces the seizure list, draws the attention of the Court and
submits that the petitioner is the owner of the godown and the
other co-accused is also associated with him.

Having considered that huge quantity of contraband
was recovered in the present case, the issues canvassed by the
petitioner are purely questions of facts to be decided in course
of trial. As such, at this stage, I am not inclined to release the

petitioner on bail as the rigors of section 37 of the NDPS Act is attracted.

Consequently, CRM (NDPS) 989 of 2025 is dismissed.

Report submitted by the NCB be kept with the record.
