Learned counsel for the State opposes the bail prayer contending that the investigation reveals that he is the stockiest and supplier of the narcotic substance. He further submits that several CDR was detected during investigation in between the present petitioner and the co-accused. He further

submits many chats, voice records, sharing of bank account through Whats App are found with the co-accused persons regarding deal of illegal narcotic substance.

Having considered the submissions made on behalf of both the parties, it appears that though the petitioner is not FIR named but investigation reveals that the present petitioner fails to overcome the restrictions imposed under Section 37 of the NDPS Act, the prayer for bail made by the petitioner is rejected.

Accordingly, CRM (NDPS) 992 of 2025 is disposed of.
