Learned counsel for the opposite party at the outset has submitted the order which is assailed in the present petition, followed CRR 3505 of 2024 and Hon'ble Justice Joymalya Bagchi as His Lordship then was, vide order dated 3rd October, 2024 disposed of the petition reaffirming the order of the learned Judicial Magistrate.

Since the impugned order has already been undergone scrutiny of the Co-ordinate Bench of this Court, the court considers that there would be no purpose of continuing the present petition in any case.
