An application for anticipatory bail under Section 482 of the Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita, 2023 in connection with Ketugram P.S. Case No.301 of 2024 dated 11.07.2024 under Sections 80(2)/103(1)/85/61(2) of the BNS.

Report filed by the State is taken on record.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner got married to the victim deceased on 22.01.2024. On 18.03.2024, he went abroad. The victim committed suicide on 10.07.2024 at her matrimonial home. The petitioner is no way connected with the alleged offence.

Learned counsel for the State strongly opposes the prayer for anticipatory bail and submits that torture was meted out by the husband and the in-laws. Reliance is placed on the post-mortem report and the statements of the relatives and neighbours of the accused. More importantly, a proclamation has already been issued against the present petitioner.

Considering the incriminating materials available in the case diary and the fact that a proclamation has already been

issued against the present petitioner, I do not consider this to be a fit case for granting anticipatory bail.

The application for anticipatory bail is, thus, rejected.
