C.R.M. (A) 2945 of 2025

In Re:- An application for anticipatory bail under Section 438 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 corresponding to Section 482 of the Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita, 2023 in connection with Bhagwanpur PS Case No.283/2025 dated June, 2025 under Sections 135(1)(b) and (d) of the Electricity Act, 2003 read with amendment Act, 2007.

Learned counsel appearing on behalf of the petitioner and the WBSEDCL submit that 50% of the finally assessed amount has already been paid.

Heard the learned counsel for the State.

Considering the above and in view of the materials available in the case diary and the fact that charge sheet has already been submitted, I am inclined to grant anticipatory bail to the present petitioner.

Accordingly, in the event of arrest, the petitioner shall be released on bail upon furnishing a bond of Rs.10,000/- with two sureties of like amount each, one of whom must be local, to the satisfaction of Arresting Officer and subject to the conditions as laid

down under Section 438 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, corresponding to Section 482 of the Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita and on further condition that the petitioner shall not threaten or intimidate witnesses or tamper with evidence in any manner whatsoever.

The application for anticipatory bail being **C.R.M. (A) 2945 of 2025** is, thus, allowed.
