This application under Article 227 of the Constitution of India is at the instance of the defendants praying for a direction upon the learned Civil Judge (Sr. Division), 3rd Court at Howrah to dispose of Title Suit No. 92 of 2010 expeditiously.

Learned advocate appearing for the petitioners submits that some interlocutory applications are pending in the said suit and prays for a direction upon the learned trial judge to dispose of the same expeditiously.

In view of the order sought and proposed to be passed, there is no necessity to direct issuance of any notice upon the opposite parties.
