Aniruddha Roy, J :

1. Affidavit of service filed in Court is taken on record.
2. The petitioner claims interest on delayed payment of terminal benefits. The petitioner superannuated from service of the WBTCCL

on **June 30, 2024**. He received his provident fund benefits of **Rs.39,11,018/-** towards provident fund on **May 22, 2025**.

3. The petitioner is entitled to interest for the period from **July 01, 2024** to **May 22, 2025** at the rate of 6 per cent per annum. Let the same be paid to the petitioner by the WBTCL within a period of one month from date.
4. In default of payment as directed above, the rate of interest shall stand increased to 9 per cent per annum.
5. The writ petition is disposed of.
6. There will be no order as to costs.
