Petitioner is aggrieved by the act and action of the private respondents as he felt insecure so far as his shop room is concerned wherein he complains against the private respondents for interference of peaceful enjoyment to carry on his trade and business.

State has already taken steps under section 126/135(3) of the BNSS. Consequently, I direct the police authorities to continue their surveillance and ensure that further breach of the peace do not take place.
