1. None appears on behalf of either of the parties. No accommodation is sought for. Even on earlier occasion, none appeared on behalf of either of the parties at the time of call.
2. This case is pending since 2018.
3. Considering the nature of prayer and long pendency of this case, it seems to this Court that the petitioner is not interested to proceed with the case.
4. Accordingly, CRR 2749 of 2018 is, thus, dismissed for default. Consequently, all connected pending application, if any, is also dismissed.
5. Interim order, if any, stands vacated.
