This application under Article 227 of the Constitution of India is at the instance of the plaintiff praying for a direction upon the learned Civil Judge (Sr. Div.), 1st Court at Barasat to dispose of Title Suit No.627 of 2022 expeditiously.

The learned advocate appearing for the petitioner submits that application under Order 39 Rule 1 and 2 of the Code of Civil Procedure is still pending and the defendant has not yet filed the written statement.

In view of the order sought and proposed to be passed there is no necessity to direct issuance of any notice upon the opposite parties. However, the learned advocate for the petitioner shall be obliged to forward a copy of this application along with this order upon the opposite parties or the learned advocates representing the opposite parties before the learned trial judge.

In the light of the submission made by the learned advocate for the petitioner, CO 3050 of 2025 stands disposed of by requesting the learned Civil Judge (Sr.

Div.), 1st Court at Barasat to make an endeavour to dispose of the application under Order 39 Rule 1 and 2 of the Code of Civil Procedure filed in Title Suit No.627 of 2022 as expeditiously as possible without granting any unnecessary adjournments to either of the parties.

There will be no order as to costs.
