Learned advocate for the petitioner is aggrieved by the fact that the petitioner has been deceived and to that effect, information was furnished to the police authorities, however, no steps were taken by them.

State has submitted a report. Report reflects that Kanksa P.S. Case No.252 of 2025 dated 25.08.2025 has been registered for investigation against the private respondents. The investigation of the case is in progress and the writ petitioner has been served with a notice under Section 94 of the BNSS.

Learned advocate for the respondent nos.4 and 5 are present and disputes the accusations made in the writ petition.

Be that as it may, since the police authorities have already registered the case, they would investigate the case as per the statutory provisions and take the investigation to its logical conclusion by exhausting the provisions of law.

With the aforesaid observations, WPA 19722 of 2025 is disposed of.

There will be no order as to costs.

Report so submitted be kept with the record.

A copy of the report be handed over to the learned advocate appearing for the petitioner.
