C.R.M. (A) 3016 of 2025

In Re:- An application for anticipatory bail under Section 438 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 corresponding to Section 482 of the Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita, 2023 in connection with Kaliachak PS Case No.1207/2025 dated 01.07.2025 under Sections 329(4)/324(4)/115(2)/117(2)/74/109/303(2)/3(5) of the Bharatiya Nyaya Sanhita, 2023.

Heard the learned counsels for the parties.

Perused the case diary.

Considering the materials available in the case diary including the injury report which does not show inflicting of any grievous injury, I do not think that custodial interrogation of the petitioner is required in this case and I am inclined to grant anticipatory bail to the present petitioner.

Accordingly, in the event of arrest, the petitioner shall be released on bail upon furnishing a bond of Rs.10,000/- with two sureties of like amount each, one of whom must be local, to the satisfaction of Arresting Officer and subject to the conditions as laid down under Section 438 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, corresponding to Section 482 of the Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha

Sanhita and on further condition that petitioner shall cooperate with the investigation and to meet the Investigating Officer once a week till submission of report in final form and shall not threaten or intimidate witnesses or tamper with evidence in any manner whatsoever.

The application for anticipatory bail being **C.R.M. (A) 3016 of 2025** is, thus, allowed.
