The petitioner is in custody for about five months and prays for bail.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner is not named in the FIR and is not involved in the alleged offence. He is a resident of Jharkhand.

Learned counsel for the State and the defacto complainant oppose the prayer.

I have considered the material on record. A person was shot dead. The fire arm has been recovered at the instance of the petitioner. The bullet recovered from the body of the victim has matched with the said fire arm.

The petitioner is in custody for about five months. Offence, if proved, shall attract mandatory life imprisonment.

In view of the above, prayer for bail is rejected at this stage.

The bail application is disposed of.
