Heard the learned counsels for the parties.

Perused the case diary.

It appears that the victim's leg was fractured and the injury report discloses grievous hurt. The petitioner's role has been specifically described in the FIR and also referred to by the victim in a statement.

Considering the above and the other incriminating materials available in the case diary, I do not consider this to be a fit case for granting anticipatory bail.

Accordingly, the application for anticipatory bail is rejected.
