It is the case of the petitioners that their father was the owner of a shop room at 36 (15/D) West Dhangar Para, North 24 Parganas, Kolkata-700 122. After the death of their father, Barrackpore Municipality transferred the trade licence in favour of respondent nos. 6 to 8 behind the back of the petitioners.

Respondent nos. 6 to 8 are brothers of the petitioners.

I am of the view that this writ petition need not be kept pending.

Accordingly, this writ petition is disposed of with a direction upon the Municipality to convene a hearing giving a due notice to the petitioners, and respondent nos. 6 to 8 to consider the grievance of the petitioners.

After hearing the parties, the Municipality shall pass a reasoned order with regard to the issuance of the trade licence in respect of the shop in question.

The entire exercise shall be completed within a period of three months from the date of communication of this order.

Accordingly, **WPA 19802 of 2023** is disposed of.
