C.R.M. (NDPS) 1066 of 2025

In Re:- An application for Bail under Section 483 of the Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita, 2023, filed in connection with Kaliachak Police Station case no. 1142 of 2025 dated 23.06.2025 under Sections 21(c)/25/27A/29 of the Narcotic Drugs and Psychotropic Substances Act, 1985;-

1. The learned counsel for the petitioner submitted that the petitioner has been falsely implicated without having any incriminating elements against him. It is further submitted that nothing had been seized from the present petitioner.
2. The learned Public Prosecutor produced the Case Diary and invited attention to the statements of witnesses. It is further submitted that investigation is still going on, awaiting for finalization.
3. On perusal of the Case Diary and other materials, it is found that different witnesses named the present petitioner having direct

nexus with the perpetration of crime and dealing with contraband articles.

4. Since investigation is still going on and the allegation is serious in nature, I am not inclined to allow bail and the same stand rejected.
5. Liberty is given to file bail application at appropriate stage when the Trial Court may decide the matter on its own merits without being influenced by this order.
6. Case Diary may be returned to the Public Prosecutor.
7. Accordingly, the instant application stand disposed of.
8. There shall, however, be no order as to costs.
