This application under Article 227 of the Constitution of India is at the instance of the plaintiff praying for a direction upon the learned Civil Judge (Junior Division), 1st Court at Barasat to dispose of Title Suit No. 781 of 2017 expeditiously.

The learned advocate appearing for the petitioner submits that issues have already been framed and 18th November, 2025 has been fixed for evidence of the plaintiff witness.

In view of the order sought and proposed to be passed, there is no necessity to issue notice upon the opposite parties. However, the learned advocate appearing for the petitioner shall be obliged to forward a copy of this application along with this order upon the opposite parties or upon the learned advocates representing them before the learned trial judge.

In the light of the submissions made by the learned advocate for the petitioner, C.O. 3141 of 2025 stands disposed of by requesting the learned Civil Judge (Junior

Division), 1st Court at Barasat to make an endeavour to dispose of Title Suit No. 781 of 2017 as expeditiously as possible without granting any unnecessary adjournment to either of the parties keeping in mind that the suit is pending from the year 2017.

There shall be, however, no order as to costs.
